This includes overseeing an annual budget of \$11,000,000 and a staff of 50 employees who evaluate the safety, reliability, and quality of aeronautics and space systems fabrication, and technology or research and development activities that could evolve into space systems. Ms. Calhoun has authored and presented numerous national and international publications. She also received numerous awards throughout her career for her accomplishments, including the NASA Equal Employment Opportunity Medal for her STEM outreach efforts with underrepresented and underserved students.
